The committee focused on educating the St. Francis of Assisi Parish community on what to do in the event of Fire, Active Threat or an Earthquake. John would like approval to start up this effort again including presentations to the parishioners.

PPC agreed, and goal is for fall 2023. Sr. Libby and Marcia offered to help. Emer will send John a copy of the trifold flyer that the Safety Committee created in 2020.

Pastors Report

- Pastor shared that the Faith Formation program has wrapped up, and it was a satisfying year made successful by the volunteers.
- Beth White helped this year with CFF. Emer McKenna and Sara Pietrowski will be the CFF coordinators for the 2023-2024 Faith Formation year. The parish is in the process of hiring an office admin to handle the associated paperwork.
- Melba will prepare the students for Confirmation again next year. Next year we will be interviewing the parents and kids with a focus on family catechesis.
- Fr. Rey would like a revival of the Eucharist in the Church.
- Fr. Rey shared a vision to create one single youth group between St. Elizabeth, Sacred Heart, St. Francis and the Cathedral parishes.

- Sound system is a top priority. Parish is waiting for a proposal from the company and hoping work will be completed by September.
- Judy Miranda will be moving to Washington in late May. She will be honored at Francis Fest. Marco will provide a card at 7:30 and 9:30 masses to be signed by the council.

 - Immunizations will be provided by Safeway, main booth for tickets, a lot of items to sell, a lot of work accomplished.
- Monthly Charity Collection
 - Melba proposed that we consider reestablishing a monthly food collection.
 In the past a cart would be placed at the back of the Church for food donations food went to Loaves & Fishes and River City Food Bank.
 - Who would handle it? We would need a volunteer to coordinate it.
